Description of the program	Graduates of the program will learn how to put into practice the skills of a diplomat, understand the problems of international politics, propose and implement effective mechanisms for cooperation and mutual understanding. The program has a unique set of disciplines that help to master the full depth of international issues. Students will broaden their horizons of knowledge in the field of diplomacy and foreign policy, have the opportunity to interact with international experts, participate in international projects and exchanges, and master two foreign languages. Highly qualified teaching staff will ensure the formation of graduate competencies necessary for a successful professional career. Graduates will learn how to negotiate and work with

	foreign partners, conduct research in the field of international relations, develop intercultural skills to build effective communication and successful cooperation, will be able to establish contacts around the world, and will receive specialized computer knowledge necessary in the professional field.
Key disciplines of the educational program	Theory of international relations. World politics. Digital diplomacy. Modern international relations. International transport communications. Conducting negotiations. Theory and history of diplomacy. Diplomatic and consular service. A foreign language in professional communication (English). The second language to be studied is Russian as a foreign language.
The target audience of the program	Foreign citizens with secondary and secondary vocational education who have successfully passed the entrance exams (English and Political Geography). Those who are interested in the development of international relations in the Asia-Pacific region, the problems of interstate relations and the role of non-state actors in world politics.
Career prospects	The program prepares graduates for a successful career in government agencies, international organizations, diplomatic structures, business, PR and news agencies, analytical centers, research organizations. Graduates will be able to work in the positions of managers, heads of departments, leading specialists, employees of Foreign Ministry institutions and consulates, researchers and teachers, translators. Employment is possible in the fields of tourism, foreign economic activity, journalism, intercultural communication, and international security.
